



# MINISTER FOR SPORT AND RECREATION'S AWARD FOR INCLUSION

This Award, including a cash prize of \$3000, is awarded to a local sporting organisation or club that has demonstrated an outstanding commitment to the principles of inclusion and diversity in their sport within the nomination period. As a result of this commitment they will have set such standards of excellence as to set themselves apart from their peers, so as to warrant them being the recipient of this award.

ACT Peak Sporting Organisations, local associations and clubs may nominate for this award, with Peak Sporting Organisation also able to nominate an affiliate. Outstanding achievement for Inclusion in sport will be assessed considerate of the following:

- Development of programs and partnerships to address equality for the inclusion and participation of all members of our community;
- Engagement with and support for disadvantaged communities, not-for-profits and other cause-related organisations;
- Initiatives to equip and support the disadvantaged to overcome barriers to physical activity participation;
- Endeavors to foster diversity in the administration and governance of their sport;
- Contribution to building the identity, resilience and spirit of a local community;
- Assisting club members or the broader community to positively overcome individual, family or community challenges or adversity;
- Demonstrated ability for members to work together to achieve an outcome that benefited their community;
- Nominee must be an incorporated organisation in the ACT.
